


Population trends in Metro New Orleans parishes 1980–2023

Population change = Births – deaths + inmigration - outmigration








- U.S. had 8% more births than deaths.
- LA had 2% more births than deaths.

2020-23:

- LA is 14th youngest state.
- LA has among highest age-adjusted death rates of all states.



Louisiana had the 8th highest death rate in the nation (999 deaths per 100,000 population) in 2022.








Louisiana had the 5th highest death rate in the nation (1,070 deaths per 100,000 population) in 2020 and 2021.

Average for years 2020-21








Louisiana had the 4th highest drug overdose death rate in the nation in 2021 (56 deaths per 100,000 people).

In Louisiana, there were 10 firearm suicides per 100,000 in 2021, which is higher than the already high national rate of 8 firearm suicides.



NEW ORLEANS: GROWTH, STABILIZATION, OR DISRUPTION?

Louisiana has one of the highest pregnancy-related death rates in the nation with 44 deaths per 100,000 live births.



Sources: CDC Provisional Mortality Statistics (deaths) and CDC National Vital Statistics System (births). Notes: Data are a three-year average. State rates based on fewer than 20 deaths are suppressed because of reliability and confidentiality. A maternal death is defined as the death of a woman while pregnant or within 42 days of termination of pregnancy, from any cause related to or aggravated by the pregnancy or its management, but not from accidental or incidental causes.







Outmigration

Between 2020 and 2022...

 15 states had more outmigration than inmigration. LA ranked 6th among these states.

In 2022...

 For every 10 LA residents who moved to another state, only 7 residents came from other states to replace them.




Reasons people move long distances: 1. Work opportunities 2. Social networks





Louisiana +2%






